

President's Message



Dear friends,

I write this note with much gratitude and fulfilment. This year, Utkarsh achieved many milestones that we targeted. We took another city under wings to feed stray dogs. The stray dog feeding

drive in Shirdi, Ahmednagar District, has become a boon to the voiceless, along with providing a relief to the residents, as stray menace is now reduced.

Our vision of taking Utkarsh Rabies Mukti Mission (RMM) to every district in Maharashtra inched closer to fruition with the launch of RMM in Nanded in August 2022. We remain grateful to the wide media response we received for the launch. The anti-rabies vaccination drives are held regularly in Nanded in collaboration with Nanded-Waghala Municipal Corporation. Another highlight about RMM is the launch of Utkarsh-RMM website - www.utkarshrabiesmuktimission.org in March 2022. The website contains detailed info about RMM campaigns, the offices, helplines and more. Utkarsh Animal Hospital in Mulund, Mumbai, welcomed esteemed guests from INFAH in 2022. INFAH or the Indian Federation of Animal Health Companies is a great platform uniting companies and non-profit organisations working towards animal health care. They promote ethical practices and create awareness about effective treatments, disease control and more to improve the health and productivity of animals. INFAH has assured expert quidance to Utkarsh to ensure best animal

Utkarsh has always strived to make the voice of the voiceless heard. When we set up Utkarsh Legal Cell Against Animal Abuse, we knew there will be hurdles in the path. Animal laws have to follow stricter implementation, as in most cases, the culprits manage to escape punishment. We keep filing cases

against animal abusers, but rarely see perpetrators brought to book. Amidst disappointments, we also see many silver linings in the form of resolved human-animal conflict cases and bringing dated practices to the attention of the authorities. An example is the revoking of tender issued by Chandrapur Collector to catch stray dogs and pigs and releasing them outside city premises, after Utkarsh Legal Cell intervened. How is that possible? Strays are territorial animals. Even the law strictly prohibits relocation of strays.

Utkarsh added another feather to its cap with a humble recognition from the International Association of Lions Club. They presented me with their prestigious award for our contribution to social welfare. I thank the Lions Club for the recognition. Such moments give me strength and confidence to move ahead with our mission and vision.

We also turned year older in September 2022, as Utkarsh is now 12! Looking back at these 12 years, I feel we have indeed come a long way but there are miles ahead to travel. As every year, Utkarsh celebrated Raksha Bandhan with a difference. This year, we initiated a campaign to tie radium collar rakhis, as every year, but as a thank you to our stray siblings for protecting us all through the year against intruders. Strays bark when they spot strangers or dubious occurrences. They are, our voluntary guards and we should also do our bit to serve and protect them. Utkarsh achieved the feat of tying 6000 radium collar rakhis to strays in 6 cities, including Mumbai, Ambernath, Shirdi, Nanded, Latur, and Satara.

Utkarsh is also making waves in other movements. The Environmental Protection Campaign has conducted the successful "Say No to Single-Use Plastics" drives in Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu and Punjab. We have distributed 1,50,000 cloth bags and 10,000+ steel water bottles so far.

We have also launched a new campaign this year to fix leaky taps and save water. The "Utkarsh Save Water" Campaign was launched on 22 March 2023 on the occasion of World Water Day.

The campaign will help save our precious water resource. In Mumbai, around 650 million litres of water are wasted every day from leaky taps. It is nearly equal to Mumbai's daily shortfall of 550 million litres. Around 3.4 trillion litres of water go waste in India every year. We hope our campaign will benefit thousands of households and offices.

Women's Education and Empowerment Movement is also creating an impact with women's livelihood initiatives and skill training. More than 1000 women are now working with Utkarsh making cloth bags, radium collars, pet costumes and accessories, and more, in Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, and Punjab. Our annual Menstrual Hygiene Week Celebrations helped over 500 beneficiaries this year as the different awareness campaigns made a difference to the thinking and understanding of menstruation, in men and women.

The mission and vision of Utkarsh are about encompassing everyone and taking the campaigns to every animal and citizen in India. Our next target is to establish Utkarsh Animal Welfare Movement in 5 more districts of Maharashtra, taking the count to 10. Utkarsh Rabies Mukti Mission is actively functioning in 6 districts as of now, and we are planning to take it to another 6 districts. To

achieve the Utkarsh Mission and to mobilise people for a better world, an urgent increase in manpower and volunteers is crucial. That's a target we hope to achieve gradually.

Utkarsh is also looking forward to further collaboration with the Directorate of Environment and Climate Change, Punjab for "Say No to Single-Use Plastics" Campaigns in the state. We hope to reach every village and city in Punjab to ensure Punjab is plastic-free in the next five years.

We are also happy to share with you that in the next financial year, Utkarsh Global Foundation will be setting up its branch in Uttar Pradesh. Our first foray will be with the "Say No to Single-Use Plastics" Campaign in the state.

To conclude, I wish to thank our dear supporters and donors who have extended full cooperation to our initiatives. The struggle to ensure funding to social welfare projects will always exist, but we are grateful to those who have enthusiastically joined us and continue to help us move forward.

Let me also take a moment to thank my dear team spread in three states who are ensuring successful implantation of Utkarsh causes and making a difference in thousands of lives

-humans and animals!





UTKARSH LEGAL CELL AGAINST ANIMAL ABUSE IMPACT!

Chandrapur Collector revoked illegal tender!

Warora Municipal Council revoked the tender and agreed to conduct ABC (Animal Birth Control) Programme, thanks to the intervention of Utkarsh Legal Cell.

Warora Municipal Council had issued a tender (dated 4 April 2022) to catch stray dogs and pigs and release them outside city and district premises. It is illegal to do so. Animal welfare laws have clearly stated that placing animals outside their original territory amounts to cruelty to animals. Utkarsh Legal Cell Against Animal Abuse took up the matter and wrote to the CMO, Maharashtra about the matter.

We also met them to appraise them of the tender. The Collector of Chandrapur took action and the tender was revoked. The Municipal Council is all set to implement ABC, as it is the only way to control and manage stray population.

Meeting with animal lovers about Utkarsh ABC

Adv. D. R. Londhe, President, Utkarsh Global Foundation, met animal lovers in Borivali on 28 April 2022 to appraise them about Utkarsh ABC (Animal Birth Control) programme. While the AWBI or the Animal Welfare Board of India has strict guidelines about the dos and don'ts of ABC, Utkarsh goes a step beyond through its unique SOP (Standard Operating Procedure). The four-step procedures in Utkarsh ABC includes:

- Videography of the catching and releasing process of the dogs to note and ensure the exact location
- 7-in-1 vaccination to the dogs at the time of admission to prevent viral infections
- Complete blood examination of the dogs before the surgery
- Tying radium collars on the dogs upon their release. The radium collars reflect light and save strays from accidents at night

#StrayTogether in Mulund

Utkarsh conducted #StrayTogether at Sai Aasha Deep Society Cooperative Housing Society on S. L. Road in Mulund (West). Around 6 dogs were sterilised and vaccinated in the drive conducted on 13 June 2022. #StrayTogether also helped resolve human-animal conflict in the society. A mother dog had given birth to six puppies. The society members were scared about the increasing dog population. The animal feeders in the locality were providing food to the dogs but had not vaccinated and sterilised the mother dog. Utkarsh sterilised the mother dog and vaccinated her, as a part of Utkarsh ABC, and the puppies against rabies and administered them the 7-in-1 vaccine. Utkarsh also initiated feeding drive for the dogs so they would remain calm and not bark at night. Utkarsh also got all the 6 puppies adopted. The society members were pleased and impressed with the Utkarsh initiative and sponsored a day's feeding drive. Mr. Chandresh Bhanushali, Chairman, Sai Aasha Deep Society, Mulund (W) "#StrayTogether helped our housing society find balance between humans and animals, thus helping in preventing human-animal conflict. What an excellent initiative by Utkarsh!"

Assaulted dog rescued from Bhandup Bhakti, a student, and animal lover, called Utkarsh to report about a man who assaulted his dog daily. She also recorded a video of the man hitting the poor dog. We reached the location in Bhandup (West). His caretaker, a mentally challenged person, drunk, assaulted the poor dog every day and left him alone, starving, in a dark rom. We rescued him and admitted to Utkarsh Animal Hospital in Mulund. He was happy and hale within a few days. He is doing well and is currently staying in our hospital, loved by everyone.

Training @ Utkarsh

Staff Training at Utkarsh Animal Hospital, Nanded

Adv. D. R. Londhe, President, Utkarsh, conducted a training session for the staff of the hospital on 5 May 2022. The topics included new techniques for cleanliness and hygiene at the hospital, effective ways to conduct ABC, advanced ways of treatment, proper ways to maintain records, and action plan for Rabies Mukti Mission – 2025 in Nanded. The session also discussed suggestions and plans for the upcoming daily feeding drive in Nanded.





Training for animal catchers at Utkarsh Animal Hospital, Mumbai

A detailed training session was held at Utkarsh Animal Hospital, Mumbai on 10 March 2023 to make the staff aware about the right ways to catch stray dogs. A demonstration on using the catching net was also held. The training session also threw light on the safety measures to be followed. Stray dogs must be caught and admitted to Utkarsh Animal Hospitals for sterilisation surgeries, treatment, and vaccinations. Catching dogs using prescribed procedures and correct techniques prevent injuries to the dog and the catcher.

Waste Management Workshop

A workshop on the ways and importance of proper segregation of biomedical waste was held for the staff at Utkarsh Animal Hospital, Mumbai on 11 March 2023. The session, conducted by Mrs. Harsha Darpe (Operations Department), elaborated on the types of biomedical waste, the different coloured bins to be used and on the ways to handle the waste.




Unique Cases at Utkarsh


